Jamia Tableegh-ul-Quran was established in 1998 at Yousafabad Peshawar City and spreading Islamic education, teachings of Islam (Quran, Sunnah and Fiqa) ever since. The Jamia is trying to spread religious education to reform the society, undertaking social work for the good of the people and above all, spreading the message of the Holy Quran through translation and detailed explanation with an aim.

Aim:

Concordant to the demands of the time a religious, reforming, ideological and educational institution.

Reformation of the society, having a clear conception to Islamise the society.

Vision of Jamia:

Jamia envisage to enlighten all walks of the society with the Quranic teachings by presenting them in a practical way.

Rationale to choose Jamia for seeking religious education.

The distinguished feature of the Jamia are:-

- 1) It uses modern methods, instruments and technology for imparting religious education to the students.
- 2) Male and female students are educated in different shifts. Every person, according to his mental capacity can find ample opportunities here to get religious education.
- 3) For general students, the Jamia offers long and short term courses. The students can come to get education and training according to their need, capacity and aptitude.

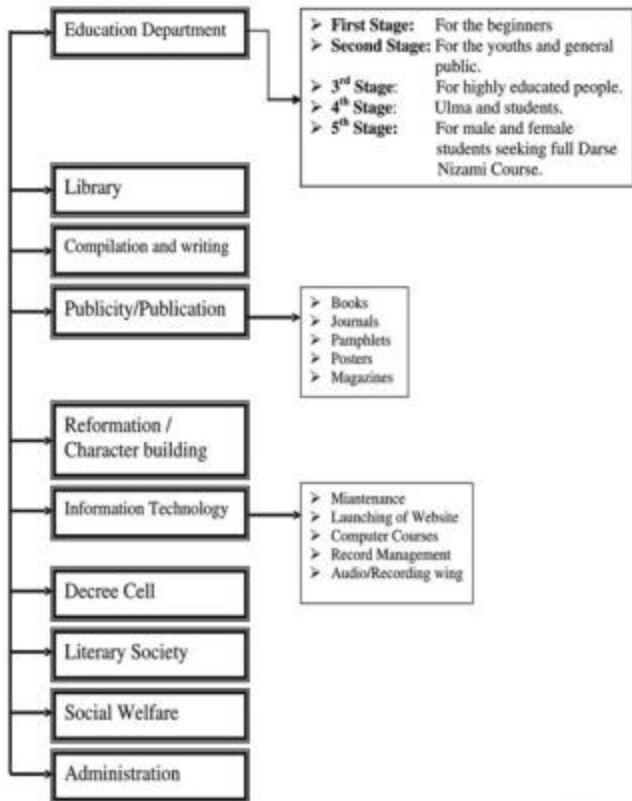
- 4) The Jamia has established a welfare organization, namely “Khadim Welfare Society” which collects donations to extend financial help to the poor, needy, orphans and widows.

Facilities at the campus of jamia:

A 5-story building of the Jamia, equipped with all modern facilities, is located in the heart of the City. It is the hub of activities of the Jamia where inward and outward training of the pupils is carried out. The building of the Jamia contains the following facilities:-

DEPARTMENTS OF JAMIA TABLEEGH-UL-QURAN



Education Department:

The Jamia is providing Islamic education free of cost. Having regard to age, gender and timings, short term and long term courses of different duration are offered to the students as under:-

Ist Stage: It is for the beginners.

Course: Nazira, Hifz and verbatim translation of the Holy Quran.

Training in early age greatly affects the future life, so it is necessary that proper arrangement for giving religious education in early life is made.

Co-curricular activities:

Besides their prescribed course, the beginners also get training as follows:

- i) An introduction to basic beliefs.
- ii) To learn Masnoon Supplications and azkars
- iii) To learn Names of Allah (swt)
- iv) To learn Short sayings of the Holy Prophet (saw)
- v) Inspiration to good deeds.
- vi) Ills of bad deeds.
- vii) Ills of bad company and watching TV (with regard to vulgarity).
- viii) To learn art of speech.

Education Criteria:

To evaluate educational ability of the students, monthly tests are given to them, based on the curriculum and co-curriculum.

Timings: Classes take place in the noon, afternoon and in the evening.

2nd Stage:

Prescribed for the youths and general public. Now a days Muslims are over-welcomingly absorbed in worldly affairs and are unmindful of religious education. For establishment of a peaceful and just society, religious education is very necessary. In view of this situation, those who do not have religious education, are educated and trained in this stage on part-time basis.

Prescribed course:

- i) Translation and explanation of the Holy Quran to become familiar with Islamic teachings.
- ii) Brief instructions about the sayings of the Holy Prophet (saw).
- iii) To teach fiqa about day to day matters.

Timings: Classes are held after Maghrib and Eisha Prayers.

3rd Stage:

Prescribed for those who have got modern education.

Prescribed Course:

- i) Quran-e-Kareem, translation, explanation and asool-e-tafseer.
- ii) Sayings of the Holy Prophet (saw) and asool-e-Hadith.
- iii) Fiqa and asool-e-fiqa.
- iv) Arabic grammar, conversation in Arabic language and to learn the art of oration.
- v) Ilm-e-Meras (Laws of inheritance)
- vi) Life style of the Holy Prophet (saw) and Islamic History.
- vii) Skill in preaching / spreading of Islamic teachings.
- viii) Explanation about basic belief.

There are two kinds of education system current in our country. One education system is called the **Western Education**, consisting of basic/solid sciences, Engineering, Technology, medical sciences and Social Sciences etc. Other kind of systems is called **Religious Education**, which purely deals with Islamic teachings. There is a marked polarity between the two systems of education. This polarization has also driven a wedge in Muslims. Therefore, it is deeply felt that there should be blending of modern and religious education for better result to meet the challenges of present time.

It is of utmost importance for the Muslims to get knowledge of both systems of education, so that they may get success in both the worlds-here and hereinafter. To bridge the gap, a 4-year course has been designed which consists of Islamic education and other co-curricular activities to make the course multi faceted, so that to broaden the vision of the students to get versatility.

Co-Curricular activities:

- i) To hold seminars, workshops, symposiums on important topics for enlightenment of the students.
- ii) Trained in writing, rhetoric and competitions.
- iii) Useful groups-discussion are arranged.
- iv) Study tours are conducted.
- v) Arrangement for personal studies are made.

Evaluation Criteria:

The 4-year course is semester based. There are 08 semesters. Mid term and final exams are given to the students in each semester. Not only scholastic skill of the students its examined, but also their ability in co-curricular activities is assessed.

Timings: Classes are held daily after Maghrib & Aisha.

4th Stage:

To get specialization in one subject out of the (short courses). To get specialty in a particular subject, different short courses are offered as follows:

Detail of courses:

1) دورة تفسير القرآن (Brief account of explanation of the Holy Quran)

Duration:

45 days during summer vacation which is largely attended by the students and general public.

It provides an opportunity to the participants to understand true spirit of Deene Islam, in depth knowledge of the divine book, Quran, and to know about the commandments of Allah (swt) given in the Holy Quran.

2) دورہ میراث (Revision of laws of inheritance)

Duration: 10 days

It is a useful short course for ulmas, students and lawyers. Principles and laws as ordained in the Holy Quran about inheritance are explained according to scientific formula of mathematics. Solutions to the problems are elaborated in a simple way.

3) Dura Tajveed-ul-Qran: دورہ تجوید القرآن

Duration: 30 days

The course is offered to the students and general public. The reader should recite the Holy Quran according to the prescribed principles and correct pronunciation, is the basic aim of this course.

4) Tealeem-e-Deen course: تعلیم دین کورس

Duration: 30 days

The course is offered to the students and general public. The course aims at to teach basic commandments of Islamic teachings pertaining to daily life with due regard to the demands of present time. It is a comprehensive course, which provides valuable knowledge of Islamic teachings to the participants in a very short time.

5) Short Teacher Training Course:

Duration: 10 days

This short course for teachers to train is them to transfer authentic religious knowledge to the students in an effective manner.

6) Al-Arabia baina Yadaika (Arabic Language Course).

Duration: 45 days

This course is offered to the students and general public. The course aims at learning of Arabic Language in a short period through homework exercises carried out in conducive condition.

7) Haj Training Course:

Duration: 07 days

It is meant for the intending pilgrims. Special class is held for the intending Pilgrims to enlighten them with Haj rites, likely problems to be faced by them during journey to the holy places with the help of charts, pictures and audio-visual aides. The intending Hujajs are also given instructions about their needs and solutions to problems are offered for their convenience.

8) Computer training course:

Duration: 01 month

The course is open for the students and religious scholars. The department of Information Technology offers various software courses.

The training includes:

Introduction to computer system, Basic computer usage, art of composing, Internet recording and file management etc.

5th Stage: Darse Nizami

Duration of the course: i) 08 years
(For male students)

ii) 04 years
(for female students)

It is a comprehensive Aalim / Aalima course and all essential branches of knowledge and arts are taught by stages.

Fazil-e-Deenyat Course (For Females):

Duration: 03 years

This 03 year course is offered to only females. After completion of the course, a Muslim woman becomes fully convent with Islamic teachings and becomes a true knowledgeable person that can turn the society around into a heaven by spreading / practicing the message of Islam.

Library:

In an educational institution library is of utmost importance. There is a rich library in the Jamia which contains a large number of books, Journals, reference books and encyclopedia for research and extensive study of the students. Not only the students of the Jamia benefit from the Library, but also outsiders visit the Library.

Department of writing and compilation:

The Department of writing and compilation undertakes the responsibility of writing and compiling books, literature and research topics etc. This department carries out the responsibilities of writing of material in various languages, translations, proof-reading and compilation of the written matter. This department has, so far, published more than 30 books besides several books are in the process of writing and compilation.

Publicity / Publishing:

Publicity and publishing wing is responsible for publicity and publishing of the Jamia according to the directions of the administration of the Jamia. This department has, so far, managed to publish hundreds of books, journals, posters and pamphlets for the Jamia.

A quarterly Journal "Al-Ilm" which contains topics of varied nature and highlights activities of the Jamia.

Besides, this Wing also arranges audio-cassettes of educational programmes and MP3 CDs which covers Dora-e-Tafseer-ul-Quran, seminars, lectures and sermons delivered on Jumat-ul-Mubarak by Molana Mufit Muhammad Ayaz.

Reformation and character building:

The Jamia takes care to hold meetings / gatherings from time to time on the topics like, good deeds and its reward, bad deeds and its ill-effect on the wrongdoer, persuasion to good moral acts and virtues and to protect oneself from evils and false-beliefs. All and sundry avail themselves of such sermons and consequently good number of people have reformed themselves and following the right path. On the occasion of Jumas and Eid congregations, sermons are delivered and participants are urged to righteousness and reform themselves in the light of Islamic teachings.

Information Technology:

The Department of Information Technology not only discharges its own responsibilities, but also helps the Jamia in its functions. The IT Department of Jamia has been doing the following important functions:-

Website: Preaching the teachings of Islam at International level. For on-line courses, Questions-answers session, a site: www.alishaat.com has been launched, which is updated from time to time.

This website shows aims and objectives of the Jamia, information about future programmes and highlights various activities of the Jamia.

Department of Listening:

It is subordinate department of Information Technology Department. It carries out the responsibility of computerizing of lecturers, seminars, sermons etc and prepares CDs. Besides with the help of the department of Publicity and Publications bring them out for the benefit of the people.

House of decrees:

Hazrat Muhammad (saw) is the last Prophet of Allah (swt) and this Ummah is the last Ummah. Allah (swt) has sent Islam as ever-lasting religion, whose teachings are practicable till the day of judgment. In all ages, the religious scholars have guided the Muslims on new matters in the light of Islamic laws. The house of decrees of the Jamia plays the same role and offers solution to a problem in the light of Quran and Sunnah for the benefit of people. Besides, the Jamia also settles disputes between the disputants parties and save them from unnecessary tension and litigation.

Literary Society:

To inspire the students to take part in literary activities and to make them good orators, their groups are framed to practice and develop their skill in this regard. They learn the art of calligraphy. The students are prepared to get mastery in the art to cultivate effective and forceful style of speech, suitable tone and tenor, confidence in oration, giving logical rational arguments, and quoting apt examples. The society hold periodical meetings so that the students should learn this methodology.

Social welfare Programme:

It is the core spirit of Islam to serve the needy people selflessly as far as possible and it is a great means to get blessings of Allah (swt). In this connection, under the supervision of the Jamia, an organization namely "Khadim Welfare Society" has been established, which extends moral and financial support to orphans, widows, poor and needy people of the society.
